(style: TITLE)

Abstract (Style: ABSTRACT)

In this paper, we can see a summary of the styles for papers to be presented in the conference proceedings. The **Abstract** word should be 10-point bold TIMES NEW ROMAN, single-spaced, centered and with a blank line before and after the word. The Abstract text should be 10-point non-bold TIMES NEW ROMAN, single-spaced and fully justified. All the paragraphs should be indented 0,5 cm and with an additional margin on both sides of 1 cm. Please do not place any additional blank line between paragraphs. (Style: ABSTRACT_TEXT)

Key Words : The key words should be 10-point italic TIMES NEW ROMAN, single spaced, flush left and with a blank line before and after the paragraph.(Style: KEYWORDS)

1 Paper format (Style: Heading 1)

All the paper are to be in one-column format. The paper size must be A4 (210 mm x 297 mm). The margins must be:

- Top: 2 cm
- Bottom: 2 cm
- Left and Right: 2 cm

2 Section (Introduction, Materials and methods...) (Style: Heading 1)

The first-order heading, (For example **2 Section**) should be TIMES NEW ROMAN 14-point boldface, initially capitalized, flush left, with a 6-point blank line before, and one 12-point blank line after. It should have 3 blank spaces between the section number and the text. (Style: heading 1)

2.1 Subsection (Style: heading 2)

The second heading, (For example **2.1 Subsection**) should be TIMES NEW ROMAN 12-point boldface, initially capitalized, flush left, with a 6-point blank line before, and one 12-point blank line after. It should have 3 blank spaces between the section number and the text. (Style: heading 2)

3 Main text

The main text of paragraphs should be TIMES NEW ROMAN 12-point style, non-boldface, single spaced, fully justified and with a 6-point blank line after each paragraph. All paragraphs should be indented 0,5 cm. Do NOT use double-spacing. (Style: Standard)

6 Equations and symbols

Use 11-point Greek letters and mathematical symbols to make the equations.

7 Footnotes

Please use footnotes¹ sparingly and place them at the bottom of the page on which they are referenced. Use 8-point TIMES NEW ROMAN, single-spaced.

8 References

List and number all bibliographical references in 10-point TIMES NEW ROMAN, single-spaced, at the end of your papers (Style REFERENCES). Give all author's names, do not use "*et al.*". When referenced in the text, enclose the citation in square brackets, for example [1]. See examples below.

- [1] Name1 Initials1., Name2 initials2. and Name3 initials3. (time new roman, 10). Title (time new roman, 10). Name of the periodical (time new roman, 10, underlined), volume number (time new roman, 10, **bold**), beginning-end of page numbers (time new roman, 10), year (time new roman, 10).
- [2] Author I.M. Article title. In *Journal or Proceedings of Intelligent Everything*, Vol. II, N° 7, pp. 25-28, January 1999.
- [3] Person A., *The Book Title*, the Publisher, Gandia 1999.
